Rail Strike

We have been advised by West Midlands trains of disruption to the local train services as follows ‘

‘As a result of planned strike action, rail services will be heavily disrupted throughout the duration of next week. Whilst strike action is currently planned for Tuesday 21st June, Thursday 23rd June, and Saturday 25th June, the knock-on impact means that we are also expecting Monday 20th, Wednesday 22nd June and Friday 24th June to be similarly disrupted. On our Snow Hill Lines (Worcester, Kidderminster, Hagley, Stourbridge, Solihull, Stratford-upon-Avon, etc), we will not be operating any services from Tuesday 21st June through to Saturday 25th June. On Monday 20th June there will be one service per hour running between Birmingham Snow Hill and Kidderminster only. Similarly, Chiltern Railways are not planning to run any services north of Dorridge.’
