Sports Fixtures/School Trip Return Times

We have had a few queries in the office from parents about pick times from School Sports Fixtures and Trips. Please note that the 'Approx. finish' time provided in the Bulletin is the time the match itself finishes. The 'Approx. return' is the time that the students will be back at School. For away fixtures, where you wish to pick your son/daughter from the opposition venue, please make sure you arrive by the finish time, otherwise PE staff will bring your son/daughter back to School on the minibus/coach. If you are picking up from School following an away fixture, please make sure you arrive by the return time, but do watch the School Twitter account(s) for updates. For home fixtures at Manor Road, we only provide a finish time so that parents can judge whether they need to pick their son/daughter up or whether they can get their usual bus / train home. Please note that if a specific department is running a trip, then updates may be posted by the relevant departmental Twitter account.

Medical Care Plans and Medication

Given the number of trips that are taking place between now and the end of term, we would like to remind parents, that if we have a care plan in place for your child, this will be used for School trips unless parents advise us of any changes. This means that if medication, dosage or diagnosis changes in any way, then please send updated Medical Care Plans to Student Services via studentservices@kes.net and do review the data you have provided us with on a regular basis. We would also like to re-iterate that if your son/daughter has been prescribed an inhaler or auto-injector (EpiPen), they must carry these on any School trips even if the usage of such medication is only rare or occasional. Trip Leaders will check with students before setting off on any trip and those without the necessary medication will not be able to take part in the trip.
