Performance Track and Field - Wednesday 28th June

Our annual Performance Track and Field Championship, the final event of the 2022-2023 House Competition, takes place this year on **Wednesday 28th June at 5.30pm**.

To allow time for students to make their way home before congregating at Warwick University Track (CV4 7AL) for a **5.30pm** start, School finishes at **1.15pm**. If your son/daughter wishes to stay at School, then they may pass the time in the School Library until they set off for the event, or they need to make their way home at their usual time and via their usual route. Since there will be no meal service available for Years 7 – 11, they should bring a packed lunch with them.

For those who are not travelling directly to Warwick University from home, a coach will be leaving the Dairy Gate at **4.30pm** to transport students to the track. If your son/daughter would like to have a seat on the coach, please ensure they complete the form that will be shared on their Year Group Microsoft Team on **Wednesday 14th June**, as seats are limited.

All competitors will need to meet at the track at **5.15pm** in PE kit (white socks, blue shorts and blue polo shirt) and K.E.S. Sport clothing (if possible) for Years 7-10, and ideally K.E.S. sport clothing for Year 12. Female students are advised to wear appropriate sports leggings/clothing and K.E.S. sports clothing if they have it. Each competitor will be supplied with a House vest to wear on the night during their event. Please bear in mind the possibility of inclement weather and students are advised to bring appropriate extra warm, waterproof clothing.

The final presentations take place at **8.20pm** and the coach will return to School for approximately **9.00pm**. Students do not have to return on the coach, collection from the track is optional. Parents and supporters are most welcome and SportKES will be selling refreshments throughout the evening. Please note, on arrival at the University Track, another event will have just finished and people will be leaving the track and the car park may be busy. The car park is pay and display and there is further parking on the opposite side of Kirby Corner Road.
